**Quinton Coples / DE / North Carolina / Round 1 Pick 16 / New York Jets**

- Coples played as edge rusher for NY Jets where he recorded 16.5 sacks over
- switch from a DE to OLB after his rookie season
- Coples began to see reduced playing time in 2015 as he only made 8 tackles along with a fumble recovery in 10 games and was then released
- Out of the League since 2016

**AJ Jenkins / WR / Illinois / Round 1 Pick 30 / San Francisco 49ers**

- Jenkins was only active for 3 games a rookie, only receiving one target which he dropped
- was traded to KC Chiefs the summer before his second season
- Made very little impact in KC working as a depth receiver
- Out of the League since 2015

**David Wilson / RB / Virginia Tech / Round 1 Pick 32 / New York Giants**

- Wilson played as a rotation back as a rookie (starts) recording a 5 YPC average with with 4 TD's
- Suffered season ending neck injury in 2013
- Underwent neck surgery on January 16, 2014. On August 4, 2014, he was ruled out for the year due to his neck again.
- Due to recurring neck injuries he retirement from the NFL on August 6, 2014.

**Jonathan Martin / OT / Stanford / Round 2 Pick 42 / Miami Dolphins**

- Martin started all 16 games his rookie year at RT
- His second season he started at LT, where he struggled before moving back to RT
- As a result of a highly public, hazing + bullying controversy, Martin sat out the rest of the 2013 season after 7 games
- Traded to the 49ers in 2014 where played in 15 games (9 starts) in the 2014
- Released by 49ers in 2015, eventually retiring before the regular season citing a back injury that would have caused him to miss that entire season

**Isaiah Pead / RB / Cincinnati / Round 2 Pick 50 / St. Louis Rams**

- Pead played sparingly in his first two seasons logging only 17 carries

- Tore his ACL in the 2014 preseason
- Bounced around as a journeyman (PIT + MIA)
- Out of League since 2016 ; suffered career ending injuries in car accident in 2016 including the loss of his left leg

**Devon Still / DT / Penn State / Round 2 Pick 53 / Cincinnati Bengals**

- Still played two years as depth/rotational DL before bouncing between Bengals' active roster
- Bounced around as a journeyman (NYJ + HOU)
- Out of League since 2017 retirement

**Ryan Broyles / WR / Oklahoma / Round 2 Pick 54 / Detroit Lions**

- Broyles suffered ACL Tear in his Senior Season
- played just 21 games over three injury-riddled seasons with the Lions
- Out of League since 2015 release from Detroit

**Peter Konz / OG / Wisconsin / Round 2 Pick 55 / Atlanta Falcons**

- Konz served as backup before moving to starting RG week 7 of rookie year.
- moved over to starting C in 2013
- Out of League since 2015 release

**Mike Adams / OT / Ohio State / Round 2 Pick 56 / Pittsburgh Steelers**

- Tested positive for drug use at the Combine
- Adams was in and out of the starting lineup throughout his stint in PIT (2012-2014) due to inconsistent play
- Placed on PUP List in 2015 recovering from back surgery, releases in 2016 with failed physical
- Signed with Bears in 2016, played in 12 games (1 start) before injuring back
- Out of the league since 2016

**Brock Osweiler / QB / Arizona State / Round 2 Pick 57 / Denver Broncos**

- Osweiler played sparingly in 2012-2014 before starting 7 games (5-2) in place of Peyton Manning in the Broncos Super Bowl Season in 2015
- Parlayed that season into a four-year, \$72 million contract (\$37 million guaranteed) with the Houston Texans.

-Following one lackluster season with Houston, he was traded to Cleveland where he was released after not winning the starting QB job.

-He bounced around making spot starts after that in Denver and Miami

-Out of the league since 2018

**LaMichael James / RB / Oregon / Round 2 Pick 61 / San Francisco 49ers**

-James played in just 18 games (0 starts) in his career

-Bounced around as a fringe practice squad player

-Out of the league after one game in 2015 season

**Ronnie Hillman / RB / San Diego State / Round 3 Pick 67 / Denver Broncos**

-Hillman worked as rotational back for much of his career

-Was the starter for a good part (10 games) of Broncos 2015 Super Bowl Season (207 carries/863 yards/7 TD's)

-Was released by Broncos before the 2016 season (which he played for MIN & SD)

-Out of League since 2017

**Bryan Anger / P / California / Round 3 Pick 70 / Jacksonville Jaguars**

-Anger became the highest drafted punter since Todd Sauerbrun was chosen 56th overall in 1995

-1x Pro Bowler (2021) with Dallas

-Signed three-year deal with Dallas this offseason

-Projects as Starter for 2022 Season

**Brandon Taylor / S / Louisiana Tech / Round 3 Pick 73 / San Diego Chargers**

-Played in just 4 games (1 start) in his career

-Suffered knee injury at the end of this 2012 rookie season

-Out of the League since 2014

**Michael Egnew / TE / Missouri / Round 3 Pick 78 / Miami Dolphins**

-Appeared in only 18 games (2 starts) in his career

-Bounced around to practice squads following his release in 2014

-Out of the League since 2014

**Brandon Hardin / S / Oregon State / Round 3 Pick 79 / Chicago Bears**

-Hardin suffered a neck injury and had to be carted off the field in the preseason of his rookie year. Was placed on IR.

-Suffered broken leg in 2013 preseason and was released.

-Never played a game in his career

-Out of the league since 2014

**Jamell Fleming / CB / Oklahoma / Round 3 Pick 80 / Arizona Cardinals**

-Appeared in 46 games (starts) in his four year career

-Bounced around in those four years (ARI, JAX, BAL, KC)

-Out of the League in 2016

**Mike Martin / DT / Michigan / Round 3 Pick 82 / Tennessee Titans**

-Martin played in 46 games (5 starts) in four year career as a rotational DL

-Out of the league since 2016

**Bernard Pierce / RB / Temple / Round 3 Pick 84 / Baltimore Ravens**

-Ravens traded up in the draft to select Pierce

-Worked as a complimentary RB

-Waived by BAL in 2014 following DUI arrest, then bounced around as journeyman PS player

-Out of the League since 2017

**Dwight Bentley / CB / Louisiana-Lafayette / Round 3 Pick 85 / Detroit Lions**

-Battled injuries throughout his career

-Appeared in 20 career games (8 Starts) with DET

-Out of the League since 2015

**Jake Bequette / DE / Arkansas / Round 3 Pick 90 / New England Patriots**

-Appeared in 8 games with NE

-Released in 2014, returned to NE in 2015 as a TE but did not make the 53-man roster

-Out of the League since 2015

**Brandon Thompson / DT / Clemson / Round 3 Pick 93 / Cincinnati Bengals**

-Rotational DL who made 7 starts (all in 2013)

-Suffered torn ACL late in 2015 season

-Out of League since 2017

**Jayron Hosley / CB / Virginia Tech / Round 3 Pick 94 / New York Giants**

-Appeared in 43 games (15 starts) and recorded 2 INTs over four year career

-Out of League since 2015

**Omar Bolden / S / Arizona State / Round 4 Pick 101 / Denver Broncos**

-Worked as a return specialist for DEN over his four year career

-Was very effective in his role having the Broncos record for return averages per season

:Yds/KR: season (33.0 in 2014)

:Yds/PR: season (24.6 in 2015)

-Out of League since 2015

**Joe Adams / WR / Arkansas / Round 4 Pick 104 / Carolina Panthers**

-Returned kicks in the first three games of the 2012 season before being benched after losing two fumbles in a game against the New York Giants.

-Waived by team before his second season

-Out of League since 2013

**Devon Wylie / WR / Fresno State / Round 4 Pick 107 / Kansas City Chiefs**

-Played in 6 games his rookie season, including working sparingly as a return specialist

-Was released prior to 2013

-from 2013-2015 bounced around as journeyman PS player (ARI, TEN, SEA, SF, STL, OAK, ATL)

-Out of League since 2015

**LaDarius Green / TE / Louisiana-Lafayette / Round 4 Pick 110 / San Diego Chargers**

-Played in 53 games (28 starts) over his 5 year career

-On March 10, 2016, the Pittsburgh Steelers signed Green to a four-year, \$20 million contract that also includes a signing bonus of \$4.75 million.

-Started that season on PUP list with ankle injury, suffered concussion late in the season

-Was then released in 2017 with a failed physical designation

-Out of League since 2017

**Jaye Howard / DE / Florida / Round 4 Pick 114 / Seattle Seahawks**

- Appeared in 45 games (28 starts) over five year career
- Released by SEA after one season, then claimed by KC
- In 2016, Howard signed a two-year \$12 million deal to stay with the Chiefs through 2017 following 5.5 sack season in 2015
- Released by KC and then by CHI in 2017
- Out of League since 2017

**Joe Looney / C / Wake Forest / Round 4 Pick 117 / San Fransisco 49ers**

- Appeared in 104 games (42 starts) over an eight year career
- Worked mostly as a versatile interior OL
- Out of League since 2020

**James-Michael Johnson / LB / Nevada / Round 4 Pick 120 / Cleveland Browns**

- Appeared in 48 games (18 starts) over a four year career
- Was largely a ST, but also was a depth LB
- Moved around as journeyman fringe depth player
- Out of League since 2015

**KeShawn Martin / WR / Michigan State / Round 4 Pick 121 / Houston Texans**

- Appeared in 58 games (10 starts) over a five year career
- Worked as a return specialist with HOU
- On September 16, 2015, Martin and a sixth-round 2016 draft pick were traded to the New England Patriots for a fifth-round pick. Proceeded to start 8 games
- Released in twice 2016 (NE, SF)
- Out of League since 2017

**Nick Toon / WR / Wisconsin / Round 4 Pick 122 / New Orleans Saints**

- Placed on IR and missed all of his rookie season
- Battled injuries through his career, appearing in just 17 games in three seasons
- Out of league since 2016

**Brandon Boykin / CB / Georgia / Round 4 Pick 123 / Philadelphia Eagles**

- Appeared in 64 games (7 starts) as CB, ST, and Return Specialist

-In 2013, recored 6 INTs while a member of PHI

-On August 1, 2015, Boykin was traded to the Pittsburgh Steelers in exchange for a conditional 2016 5th-round pick

-Bounced around as depth fringe player who battled injuries

-Out of league since 2017 (last game in 2015)

**Ronnell Lewis / CB / Oklahoma / Round 4 Pick 125 / Detroit Lions**

-Appeared in 8 games as rookie, before being cut in 2013

-Out of the League since 2013

**Miles Burris / LB / San Diego State / Round 4 Pick 129 / Oakland Raiders**

-Burris became a 15 game starter in his rookie year (96 TKLs, 5 TFL, 1 INT)

-Started 31 out of 38 games in his three year career

-Last played in 2014 due to injuries, retired in 2017

-Out of League since 2014

**Christian Thompson / S / South Carolina State / Round 4 Pick 130 / Baltimore Ravens**

-Appeared in 7 games as rookie

-Thompson was suspended for the first four games of the 2013 season for violating the league's substance abuse policy. Released following suspension.

-Out of the League since 2013

**Brandon Mosley / G / Auburn / Round 4 Pick 131 / New York Giants**

-Appeared in 22 games (1 start) in two seasons

-On September 1, 2015, he was waived/injured by the Giants

-Out of League since 2015

**Jerron McMillian / S / Maine / Round 4 Pick 133 / Green Bay Packers**

-Appeared in 28 games (2 start) in two seasons

-Released after 2013 season

-Out of League since 2014

**Matt Johnson / S / Eastern Washington / Round 4 Pick 135 / Dallas Cowboys**

-Battled hamstring/foot injuries and was never able to play any games in NFL

-Out of League since 2015 retirement

-HOF All 2010's Team

-Project starter at G in 2022

### **Dominique Easley / DT / Florida / Round 1 Pick 29 / New England Patriots**

-Did not run a 40 time while recovering from ACL injury

-Has suffered four ACL tears throughout both his college and pro career

-Has worked as a rotational DL player (6.5 sacks in 41 games)

-Out of the league since 2018

### **Austin Seferian-Jenkins / TE / Washington / Round 2 Pick 38 / Tampa Bay Buccaneers**

-Did not run a 40 time. Recovering from Foot injury

-Started 29 games with 11 TD's over five year career

-Battled Injuries and numerous off-field issues

-Out of the league since 2019

**Troy Niklas / TE / Notre Dame / Round 2 Pick 52 / Arizona Cardinals**

- Did not run a 40 time. Recovering from Hernia Surgery
- In 42 games (18 starts) in Arizona through 2017, Niklas had 203 yards and 3 TD's
- Journeyman Depth player following that
- Out of the League since 2019

**Aaron Colvin / CB / Oklahoma / Round 4 Pick 114 / Jacksonville Jaguars**

- Did not run a 40 time. Recovering from ACL injury suffered at Senior Bowl Practice
- Colvin has played in 65 games (30 starts) over six year career
- On March 13, 2018, the Houston Texans signed Colvin to a four-year, \$34 million contract that includes \$18 million guaranteed and a signing bonus of \$4 million
- Since 2019, has been a fringe depth player, then PS for WSH
- Currently a FA in 2022

**Brent Urban / DT / Virginia / Round 4 Pick 134 / Baltimore Ravens**

- Did not workout while recovering from ankle surgery
- A rotational/depth run stopping DL who has played in 76 games (31 starts) during his seven year career (BAL, TEN, CHI, DAL)
- Has battled back from a number of injuries
- Currently a FA in 2022

**Todd Gurley / RB / Georgia / Round 1 Pick 10 / St Louis Rams**

- Did not run a 40 time. Recovering from ACL injury
- Has battled an arthritic knee over his career
- Gurley has over 6,000 career yard rushing with a total 79 TD's in his six year career
- On July 24, 2018, Gurley signed a four-year, \$60 million contract extension with the Rams with \$45 million guaranteed, making him the highest-paid running back in the NFL
- NFL OPOY (2017)
- 2x First Team All Pro (2017, 2018)
- Second Team All Pro (2015)

- 3x Pro Bowler (2015, 2017, 2018)
- 2x NFL Rushing TD Leader (2017, 2018)
- Out of the League since 2020

**Cedric Ogbuehi / OT / Texas A&M / Round 1 Pick 21 / Cincinnati Bengals**

- Did not run a 40 time. Recovering from ACL injury
- Played in 60 games (30 starts) over seven year career
- On May 2, 2018, the Bengals declined the fifth-year option on Ogbuehi's contract, making him a free agent in 2019.
- He only played in two games in 2018, and was a healthy scratch for most of the season.
- Since has been a journeyman/depth offensive lineman (CIN, JAX, SEA, BAL, HOU)
- Projects as a Fringe Depth Player (HOU) in 2022

**DeAndre Smelter / WR / Georgia Tech / Round 4 Pick 132 / San Fransisco 49ers**

- Did not run a 40 time. Recovering from knee injury
- Only played 2 games in 2016 before being released
- Became fringe PS journeyman after
- Out of league since 2018

**Max Garcia / OG / Florida / Round 4 Pick 133 / Denver Broncos**

- Did not workout. Recovering from shoulder injury
- Has appeared in 93 games (53) starts as an IOL over his seven year career
- After starting 11 games for ARI last season, signed with NYG for 2022
- Currently Projects as starter in 2022

**Larmey Tunsil / OT / Mississippi / Round 1 Pick 13 / Miami Dolphins**

- Chose to not workout in pre draft process
- Has started 77 games primarily at LT
- On August 31, 2019, Tunsil, Kenny Stills, and a fourth-round pick were traded to the Houston Texans in exchange for two first-round picks, a second-round pick, Johnson Bademosi, and Julien Davenport.

-2x Pro Bowler (2019, 2020)

-Projects as a starter in 2022

**Karl Joseph / S / West Virginia / Round 1 Pick 14 / Oakland Raiders**

-Did not run due to knee injury

-Has played in 65 games (49 starts) over his six year career recording 5 INT's

-Projects as a depth player in 2022

**Jaylon Smith / LB / Notre Dame / Round 2 Pick 34 / Dallas Cowboys**

-Did not run due to ACL and MCL injury

-Sat out entire rookie season due to the injury, but became starter for DAL at LB over the next four seasons

-Was released in 2021, picked up and played rotational time with GB and NYG

-1x Pro Bowler (2019)

-Currently a FA in 2022

**Myles Jack / LB / UCLA / Round 2 Pick 36 / Jacksonville Jaguars**

-Did not run due to knee injury

-Prior to the draft, Jack was confident he could play immediately, but admitted that his knee had degenerative aspects which could require micro-fracture surgery in the future

-Has started 82 games at LB over his six seasons

-Signed with PIT following 2022 release from Jacksonville

-Projects as starter in 2022

**Roberto Aguayo / LB / Florida State / Round 2 Pick 36 / Tampa Bay Buccaneers**

-Chose to not workout in pre draft process

-Aguayo was the first kicker selected in the second round since Mike Nugent, who was drafted 47th overall in the 2005 NFL Draft by the New York Jets

-Has Played just one season (22/32 FGs)

-Waived by TB in 2017, has been fringe PS journeyman since

-Out of the League 2021

**Adam Gotsis / DE / Georgia Tech / Round 2 Pick 63 / Denver Broncos**

-Did not run due to knee injury

-Has started 46 of 89 games played, recording 8 sacks over six seasons  
-Currently a FA in 2022

**Max Tuerk / C / Southern California / Round 3 Pick 66 / San Diego Chargers**

-Did not run due to ACL injury

-Inactive for whole rookie season, then was suspended for the first four games of the 2017 season after violating the NFL policy on performance-enhancing substances

-Released in 2018, and ended up playing one snap in his whole career

-On June 20, 2020, Tuerk collapsed and died of an enlarged heart, an autopsy report revealed, while on a hike with his parents in the Cleveland National Forest.

**Will Redmond / S / Mississippi / Round 3 Pick 68 / San Fransisco 49ers**

-Did not run due to ACL injury

-Missed first two season of his career

-Has played in 34 games (5 starts) since first game in 2018

-Projects as Journeyman PS in 2022 (IND)

**Shon Coleman / OT / Auburn / Round 3 Pick 76 / Cleveland Browns**

-Did not workout due to knee injury

-Started all 17 games at RT for the Browns in 2017

-Coleman was traded to the San Francisco 49ers on August 31, 2018 in exchange for a seventh-round pick in the 2019 NFL Draft. Then suffered ankle injury and underwent surgery to repair a dislocated ankle and fractured fibula in his first game.

-Projects as Journeyman PS in 2022 (IND)

**Kendall Fuller / CB / Virginia Tech / Round 3 Pick 84 / Washington Football Team**

-Did not workout due to meniscus injury

-Has started 61 games (85 played) as a slot corner back, with 11 INTs over six year career

-On January 30, 2018, the Washington Redskins agreed to trade Fuller and a third round pick (78th overall) in the 2018 NFL Draft to the Kansas City Chiefs for quarterback Alex Smith.

-On March 23, 2020, Fuller signed a four-year, \$40 million contract with the Washington Commanders

-Projects as a Starter at SCB in 2022

**Rees Odhiambo / OG / Boise State / Round 3 Pick 97 / Seattle Seahawks**

-Did not workout due to ankle injuries

-started 7 games at LT (SEA) in 2017 before suffering finger injuries

-PS type the next year (IND x2, ATL, ARI)

-Out of League since 2019

**Tyler Higbee / TE / Western Kentucky / Round 4 Pick 110 / Los Angeles Rams**

-Did not workout due to knee injury

-Has started 84 games over his six year career, scoring 17 TD's in that time

-Projects as a starter in 2022

**Devontae Booker / RB / Utah / Round 4 Pick 136 / Denver Broncos**

-Did not workout due to knee injury

-Has started 11 games in his career, has mostly played as a rotational back

-Filled in as a spot starter for Saquon Barkley in 2021 (593 yards 2 TDs)

-Currently a FA in 2022

## 2017

**Corey Davis / WR / Western Michigan / Round 1 Pick 5 / Tennessee Titans**

-Did not run a 40 time at combine or pro day while recovering from "minor ankle surgery"

-Has started 57 out of 81 potential games played over his 5 NFL Seasons

-Signed a 3-year \$37.5 million contract with NY Jets in 2021 after strong final season with Titans (984 yards in 14 games)

-Projected Returning Starter for NY Jets in 2022 after battling "core muscles injuries" last season

**Malik Hooker / S / Ohio State / Round 1 Pick 15 / Indianapolis Colts**

-Did not run a 40 time at combine or pro day while recovering from two surgeries to repair a sports hernia and a torn hip labrum

-Has suffered two additional major injuries that ended those seasons (ACL/MCL in 2017 + Achilles Tear in 2020).

-After playing in 15 games (3 starts) with Dallas Cowboys last season he re-signed on a 2 year contract extension.

-Is expected to be a strong depth player in 2022.

**Ryan Ramczyk / OT / Wisconsin / Round 1 Pick 32 / New Orleans Saints**

-Did not run a 40 time at combine or pro day while recovery from surgery on a torn hip labrum

-Ramczyk had started and played in 63 of a possible 64 games through his first 4 seasons (playing 98% of the possible snaps) at both LT and RT. Missed 7 games last season due to "knee clean-up surgery"

-On June 30, 2021, Ramczyk signed a five-year, \$96 million contract extension with the Saints, worth \$60 million in guarantees.

-He projects as a strong Returning Starter for 2022

-1st Team All-Pro (2019) & 2nd Team All-Pro (2018)

**C. J. Beathard / QB / Iowa / Round 3 Pick 104 / San Francisco 49ers**

-Skipped the 40-yard dash at the Combine due to Hamstring Injury. Also passed on running at his Pro Day despite doing other drills.

-Saw time as a spot starter for the 49ers from 2017-2020 (12 starts) where he logged a TD:INT ratio of 18:13 and completed 58% of his passes.

-Signed a 2-year deal with Jacksonville as a backup which he projects to be as well in Jacksonville for 2022

**Kendall Beckwith / LB / LSU / Round 3 Pick 107 / Tampa Bay Buccaneers**

-Did not run a 40 time at combine or pro day while recovery from surgery to repair a torn ACL

-Beckwith appeared in all 16 games (9 starts) as a rookie before suffering a fractured ankle in a car accident that required surgery in 2018. He has not played in a game since.

-He was waived with a non-football injury designation on July 28, 2020

**Eddie Jackson / S / Alabama / Round 4 Pick 112 / Chicago Bears**

-Did not run a 40 time at combine or pro day while recovery from a broken leg

-Jackson has been a strong player for the Chicago Bears, highlighted in 2018 when he led the league in INTs returned for TD's.

-2x Pro Bowler (2018, 2019)

-First Team All-Pro (2018)

-Projects as a starter on the Bears defense as 2022

2018

**Quenton Nelson / G / Notre Dame / Round 1 Pick 6 / Indianapolis Colts**

- Nelson chose not to run a 40 time at the combine (hamstring issue) or at his pro days
- Nelson has started 61 of 65 possible games (all misses last season) for the Colts and been one of the best in league while doing it
- 4x Pro Bowler (2018, 2019, 2020, 2021)
- 3x 1st Team All-Pro (2018, 2019, 2020)
- 2nd Team All-Pro (2021)
- Starter for Colts offense line in 2022

**Mike McGlinchey / T / Notre Dame / Round 1 Pick 9 / San Fransisco 49ers**

- McGlinchey chose not to run a 40 time at the combine or at his pro days
- McGlinchey started all 16 games of his rookie season and has been a key offensive line starter for the 49ers, who have appeared in a number of playoff games, including the Super Bowl after the 2019 season.
- Missed 7 games last season due to torn quadriceps
- Had his fifth year option picked up for 2022 season, projecting him as the starter at RT for the 49ers

**Billy Price / C / Ohio State / Round 1 Pick 21 / Cincinnati Bengals**

- Price suffered an "incomplete" pectoral tear during the bench press at the combine. As a result he did not run a 40 yard dash at the combine or his OSU Pro Day.
- Price was able to start his rookie season before missing 6 games with a foot injury
